UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Training Sessions

- *Little League Minor, Little League Majors*
 - Wolves undershirt/training top
 - Wolves cap
 - Long white pants
- *Senior League 70 & 90*
 - Full game-day uniform
- *Big League*
 - Full game-day uniform

Game-Day (all teams)

- Wolves playing jersey
- White pants
- Wolves cap
- Royal blue belt (*optional for U12*)
- Royal blue socks (*optional for U12*)
- Baseball cleats (*optional for Little League Minors & Majors*)

Additional information about uniforms:

- Undershirts are generous in sizing – i.e. Junior Size 12 undershirt is the same width as Junior Size 14 Jersey – suggest going for an undershirt which is a size smaller than the jersey size if wanting to wear it as an undershirt otherwise get the same sizing if using it as a training top. Sample sizing of jerseys and undershorts will be available at junior training sessions.
- Adjustable caps have a hole in the back with snaps, fitted caps do not have the hole.
- Cricket pants are acceptable for U12, however please note that having a shirt tucked in is part of playing baseball. Baseball pants are generally more closely fitted and have belt loop. If a belt and long socks are to be worn, they should be royal blue. Adjustable belts (\$10) can be purchased at junior training sessions.
- Royal blue long socks for juniors can be purchased from sports stores.



EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Fielding Glove

- Generally having your own fielding glove is ideal to ensure that fits properly and to practice catching and throwing away from training and games.
- Baseball gloves can be purchased from Rebel sports or baseball stores - Ausport, K2 and Fielders Choice.
- The club has a range of spare gloves for kids to use at training and for games.

Batting Helmet

- Ideally every child should have their own batting helmet in minimise shared equipment – these can be purchased through our online shop (\$25) and can be customised to have your child's name on the back.
- Sample helmet sizing is available to try on – ask your Team Manager or Junior Coordinator at training.
- Helmets can also be purchase from baseball stores - Ausport, K2 and Fielders Choice
- The Team Kit bags have spare batting helmets for the team to use if required.

Baseball Bat

- Ideally every child should have their own bat as these vary in size according to the child's height.
- The Team Kit bags have spare bats for the team to use if required.

Batting Gloves

- While these are not essential, batting gloves can also be useful and prevent jarring of hands and blistering when batting at training and in games – these can be purchased from Ausport, K2 and Fielder's Choice.

Other

- Boys must wear a groin protector when batting and fielding.
