Additional Uniform Information:

- Undershirts are generous in sizing. We suggest going for an undershirt a size smaller than your jersey size if wearing as an undershirt. Otherwise get regular size if using as training top
- Adjustable caps have a hole in the back with snaps to adjust size. Fitted caps cannot be adjusted.
- Royal Blue socks and belts can be purchased from sports stores along with white baseball pants.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Fielding Glove

- Generally having your own fielding glove is ideal but not necessary. This ensures this glove fits properly and having one at home enables a child to practise more, thus getting used to wearing a glove
- Baseball gloves can be purchased from most sports stores
- Our Club has a range of gloves for our Juniors to use during training and on Game Days

Batting Helmet

- Ideally each child should have their own batting helmet but once again not necessary as the Club have a selection of helmets for players to use at training and on game days.
- Helmets can be purchased from baseball stores

Baseball Bat

- Not essential to have your own but benefits of having one is that bats can be purchased to suit individual child size. Our club also has a selection of bats for players to use at training and on game day.

Batting Gloves

- Also not essential but can be useful to prevent jarring of hands and blistering when batting at training and on game days. These can be purchased from baseball stores.

Other

- Boys **MUST** wear a groin protector when batting & fielding at all times. To be purchased by player – available most sports shops. Female players who play in a catching position are highly recommended to wear a female groin protector – widely available online.
